QUALIFICATIONS:

- Possess a Grade 12 graduation diploma or equivalent, as recognized by the Ontario Ministry of Education, or completed post-secondary education at an accredited college or university as an adult student.
 - Minimum of 1 year experience in call taking and dispatching in a primary or secondary Public Safety Answering Point (PSAP).
 - Demonstrated highly developed communication skills.
 - Must be able to type minimum of Net 40 WPM.
 - Successful completion of CritiCall testing, psychological testing, background investigation and interview required.
 - Proficiency in the 10-Code and phonetic alphabet would be considered an asset.
 - Experience using Versaterm CAD, and/or CPIC would be considered an asset.
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- As 911 Communicator duties are a 24-hour operation, this is a shift work position requiring successful applicants to work all shifts of days, afternoons, and midnights.
